### ALLEN COUNTY TO TAKE DELIVERY OF NEW HAZMAT DECONTAMINATION SHOWER

(LIMA, OH) – The Allen County Emergency Management Agency will accept delivery and training on a new *Portable Decontamination System* on Monday, August 6<sup>th</sup>, 11:00 a.m. at the Bath Fire Station, 1787 N. Dixie Hwy. announced county EMA director, Russ Decker.

“The Plysu Decontamination System is the same decon system used in the Tokyo sarin gas subway attack.” Explained Decker. “The system will allow us an improved method of offering decontamination to persons exposed to hazardous chemical substances”.

“Members of the county hazmat team are trained in decontamination techniques and this will now allow those highly trained members to use the best technology available to carry out that decontamination mission.” Explained Decker. “One of the nice features of this system is its quick set-up time, approximately 15 to 30 seconds, plus its easy clean-up afterwards.”
