COUNTY MOBILE COMMAND UNIT BACK IN SERVICE

(LIMA, OH) – The Allen County mobile command unit is now back in service according to Russ Decker, emergency management agency director. The unit had been out of service since early October when it was vandalized.

After nearly \$2,500 in repairs Decker says the unit will be back to work this weekend, “We will have the mobile command unit at the Lima Mall this weekend and next as part of the Sheriff’s special Christmas shopping security detail” Decker said.

The mobile command unit is used by all law enforcement and fire departments in Allen County and was originally obtained with private donations. Authorities are still looking for the person or persons responsible for damaging the vehicle. Persons with any information should contact Crime Stoppers or the Allen County Sheriff’s Office.
