NEW WARNING SIRENS GET READY IN LAFAYETTE AND HARROD

(LIMA, OH) – Two new outdoor warning sirens are having their final wiring installed this week in Allen County according to county Emergency Management Agency director, Russ Decker.

These two new sirens will bring to nineteen, the total number of outdoor warning sirens that can be activated for tornadoes, hazardous materials releases or other emergencies explained Decker. The new sirens are located in the villages of Lafayette and Harrod.

The \$36998.00 project is being paid for through federal Community Development Block Grant dollars for Allen County with the balance from the local jurisdictions receiving the sirens.

The new sirens are expected to be on line and ready to test during Allen County's next regular monthly siren test Wednesday, August 7th at 12:00 noon.
